### *Miss School=Miss Out!*

The Department of Education has shared information on why attendance at school is so important. Here are some of the ways parents can help in ensuring good levels of attendance...

- ✓ Establish a good routine in the morning and evenings so your child is prepared for the day ahead.
- ✓ Make sure your child goes to school regularly and follows the school rules.
- ✓ Ensure your child arrives to school on time- not late.
- ✓ Arrange dental and medical appointments outside of school hours when possible.
- ✓ Always inform the school if your child is absent due to illness- this should be followed up with a written note.
- ✓ Do not take family holidays during term time.
- ✓ Talk to your child about school and take an interest in their school work (including homework). Attend parent teacher consultations and school events.
- ✓ Praise and reward your child's achievements at school.
- ✓ Always support school staff in their efforts to control; difficult or challenging behaviour.

## Feedback from Online Questionnaire

Recently we conducted an online survey regarding positive behaviour and dealing with bullying behaviour concerns within our school. 51% of families accessed the survey. 26% of families responded to this survey.

The results are as follows:

Questions	Responses
My Child is happy and settled in school	72% Always 28% Often
My child feels safe in school.	91% Always 9% Often
The school sets clear expectations for pupil's behaviour	100% Agree
The children in St Brigid's Primary School are well behaved	42% Strongly Agree 58% Agree
If my child is unhappy his/her concerns are listened to and he/she is supported	82% Always 18% Sometimes
I am confident that the school will deal with complaints or concerns I may have.	47% Strongly Agree 53% Agree
There is good communication between school and parents if I raise a concern.	77% Always 23% Sometimes
I know the school is working hard to prevent any forms of bullying behaviour.	66% Strongly Agree 34% Agree
The school takes effective steps to respond to all forms of bullying behaviour.	49% Strongly Agree 40% Agree 11% Could not Comment

Over the coming Term we will continue to work with parents and children so we can improve the percentage of families who feel if their child is unhappy his/her concerns are **always** listened to and they are **always** supported. We will continue to build on the communication between home and school.

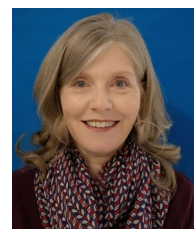
## Safeguarding in St Brigid's PS
