Safeguarding Reminders...

To ensure that our school is fully reflecting the Safeguarding and Child Protection regulations set out by DENI, parents are not permitted to visit classrooms without the permission of the Principal. Parents needing to speak to the class teacher must report to the office, where an appointment will be made to facilitate this request. For urgent meetings with a class teacher the Principal will arrange for the class teacher to come to the office to meet with the parent. Children who arrive at school after 9.00am must be left at the main door. Parents are not permitted to escort them to their cloakrooms or classrooms. This is by no means to take away from our Open Door Policy and therefore I ask for your full cooperation with this matter.

Once again November has been a busy and exciting month in school. In a response to parental and pupil questionnaires, we have organised a number of great after school clubs. We appreciate that there is a tremendous demand for these clubs and will continue to explore ways to meet the demand and further improve the opportunities on offer.

On Monday 4th November all staff engaged in training on a whole school approach in the teaching of reading and promoting a reading for pleasure culture within the school. Consequently, staff and pupils are sprucing up their classroom library corners and engaging in fun reading activities. We hope to have more guided reading resources into Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 in the next term. All children celebrated book week during the week of 19th November.
