Breakfast club should be left to school before 8.45am. Children wishing to avail of the Breakfast Club Facility but not wishing to have breakfast should pay 50p to cover the cost of adult supervision.

We now offer after school care from 2.00pm until 5.00pm each day. This club is run by Miss Mc Quoid and Mrs Magee. The children can attend for an hour, 2 or 3 to meet your needs.
